BAU participates in the Times Higher Education (THE) Impact Rankings since 2019. Also, BAU is ranked among the top 5 universities in Türkiye.

Digital Art Entrepreneurship Training “D-Art House” (2022)

D-Art House is the digital art entrepreneurship training program within the scope of the Ministry of Culture and Tourism’s Support Program titled “Young the Future” in order to increasing the creativity and entrepreneurship potential of youth in culture industries in Türkiye. The program will provide specialized training for artists and/or entrepreneurs aged 18-29 aimed to improve their know-how and skills to produce work in creative industries within the scope of digital arts. The final creative output will be exhibited in a virtual gallery that will bring the creatives and potential investors together. BAU Hub Incubation Center is one of the collaborators of the project.



Bahçeşehir University Conservatory is at Gümüşlük Festival

Bahçeşehir University Conservatory met with music lovers at the theatrical concert "Telling Beethoven" at the International Gümüşlük Music Festival.

Bahçeşehir University Conservatory instructors' theatrical concert "Telling Beethoven", which is considered a first, met with classical music lovers on the stage of the 19th International Gümüşlük Music Festival. In this project, the works of Ludwig Van Beethoven, one of the greatest composers in the world, were integrated with scenes depicting the turning points in his life. In this original performance, which lasted approximately one hour, two violin and piano sonatas were combined with three short theater scenes.

After the concert, Festival Art Advisor Pianist Gülsin Onay thanked her by saying, "We experienced a very different concept and a first in our festival, a theatrical music evening." Then, he invited Bahçeşehir University (BAU) Board of Trustees Chairman Enver Yücel and Bahçeşehir University (BAU) Conservatory Director Aslıhan Umar to the stage. President Yücel said, "As Bahçeşehir University, which has always stood by art and artists, we want to support the International Gümüşlük Music Festival in its 20th year." He congratulated the artists who took part in the concert and those who contributed to the festival and said, "You are doing great things." Meanwhile, Turkish folk music artist Ümit Tokcan came to the stage and sang the folk song "Hekimoğlu".

The first concert of BAU Conservatory Ümit Tokcan Folklor Research and Application Unit, "The Voice of Deep Roots", took place on Wednesday, May 18, at 20:00 at BAU Pera Stage.



"Tracing Anatolian Music" Online Panel Held

In cooperation with BAU Conservatory and Hacettepe University Ankara State Conservatory and with the contributions of the Anatolian Music Cultures Association, academics from important universities of our country and the world took part as speakers on the theme of "Tracing Anatolian Music from Past to Present: Change and Transformation of Folk Music in Turkey in the Historical Process". The online panel took place in two sessions on Monday, April 25, 2022, between 13:30 and 17:30.

The panel started with the opening speech of Bahçeşehir University Board of Trustees Culture and Arts advisor and Conservatory Director Aslihan Umar. Panel coordinator and BAU Conservatory Deputy Director Lecturer. After İsmet Aydın announced the moderators and sessions and gave a speech about the content of the panel, H.Ü Ankara State Conservatory faculty member Prof. to moderate the first session. Dr. Cenk Güray took over the floor. In the first session, Abdullah Gül University faculty member Dr. Lecturer While member Özgür Balkılıç gave his speech titled "Music of the Republic: Folk Songs, Nationalism and Westernization", Uludağ University State Conservatory faculty member Prof. Dr. Özlem Doğuş Varlı, "The unseen heroes of the "idealization" processes of Folk Music: Simulation or canon?" He made his presentation titled: Ankara Music and Fine Arts University faculty member Prof. Dr. ITU Turkish Music State Conservatory faculty member Dr. Okan Murat Öztürk could not attend the session due to the news of his death. Süleyman Şenel responded to the question "What would you like to say about the primary roles of Radio and Turkish Music State Conservatory in the Institutionalization of Turkish Folk Music?" He continued his speech by making some criticisms of the discourse and approaches in the presentations before moving on to his answer to the question. Throughout the discussion, it was stated that folk music in Turkey has not been institutionalized and that only a limited amount of the archives are open to researchers. Again, ITU Turkish Music State Conservatory faculty member Prof. Dr. Songül Karahasanoğlu continued her speech, approaching the change process of Folk Music in Turkey from a different perspective, through the Mey instrument.



Children and Youth Theater Staged Its First Play

Bahçeşehir College Children and Youth Theater staged their first play, "Did You Hear the Sea?" with the contributions of BAU Conservatory. The theater play, which brought together children and young people, was staged at Bahçeşehir University Conservatory Pera Campus.

BAU CINEDISCUSSION ON DISARMAMENT EVENT (28.11.2022)

The Cine Discussion event, open to the public, was organized to raise awareness about disarmament through the screening of the classic film Dr. Strangelove. The event concluded with an insightful discussion moderated by Prof. Dr. Esra Albayrakođlu, Head of the Political Science and International Relations Department at Bahçeşehir University.

The primary aim of the event was to highlight the critical importance of disarmament as a global issue, emphasizing its relevance not only in real-world politics but also in popular culture, as reflected in numerous films and TV series. The screening of Dr. Strangelove served as a prime example of how disarmament has been a significant theme in cinema. Furthermore, the discussion also delved into the portrayal of gender roles in the movie, exploring the intersection of gender equality with the broader themes of war and peace. This combination of film analysis and academic discussion helped participants engage with the topic of disarmament on multiple levels, encouraging a deeper understanding of its complexities

BAU INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS THEORY TRAINING 2.0 'GAME OF THRONES' AND 'STAR WARS' SIMULATIONS OPEN PANEL (03.02.2023)

Inspired by the globally popular TV series Game of Thrones, a simulation event was held to take participants into the mystical universe of the show as a way to familiarize them with International Relations theories. The event was open to all interested participants, providing an engaging and interactive learning experience.

The innovative teaching method aimed to make the theoretical knowledge permanent through the use of gamification, helping participants better grasp abstract concepts.

Seçkin Barış Gülmez presented the Game of Thrones simulation as a tool for teaching international relations theories and also introduced the Star Wars universe as an alternative simulation option. These simulations were designed to help participants understand theoretical approaches that are often presented through abstract concepts and propositions, ensuring that the knowledge would leave a lasting impression.

By going beyond the traditional methods of instruction, the simulations offered a unique opportunity for participants to combine theory and practice, making it easier to learn complex abstract concepts and apply them to real-world scenarios.



BAHÇEŞEHİR UNIVERSITY PART-TIME CHILDREN'S CONSERVATORY OPENED IN ORDU-GIRESUN

The Part-Time Children's Conservatory, which started operating at Ordu-Giresun Enver Yücel Primary and Secondary School Campus in the Black Sea region under the consultancy of Bahçeşehir University Conservatory, opened with a concert by famous artists Ümit Tokcan, Erdal Erzincan, Yurdal Tokcan and Erman Türkili.

The education program will be provided to 4th and 5th grade primary and secondary school students in the children's conservatory created by Bahçeşehir University academics for a total of 28 weeks of education in one year, and talented students will receive a certificate at the end of four years of uninterrupted education.

The program, which started its activities in October 2023, aims to contribute to the spread of sustainable cities and communities and quality education as the first children's conservatory launched by a university in the Black Sea region.

With the support of the Republic of Turkey Ministry of Youth and Sports, Bahçeşehir University organized Film Jam Training and Event at GENÇ ALAN, the youth center established by Netflix and UNICEF in the Nurdağı (GAZİANTEP) Region, one of the regions most affected by the devastating earthquake that occurred on February 6, 2023.

In the short film shooting marathon organized with the participation of young people in the region and lasting for three days, Bahçeşehir University Cinema and Television Department academics carried out training activities with the support of Cinema and Television Department students. As part of the event, young people in the region received cinema training and shot three short films. Bahçeşehir University academics and volunteer students supported the project with the training they provided in the project, which was implemented with the aim of supporting the social and educational rehabilitation and capacity development of young people in the region where thousands of people died and survivors lost their homes and education centers in February 2023 in Turkey.

At the end of the theoretical and practical training, short films shot by young people in the earthquake region were also screened.

BAHCESEHIR UNIVERSITY LOCAL ADVOCACY SCHOOL

The Local Advocacy School, organized in collaboration between the Local Monitoring, Research, and Implementation Association (YERELİZ) and Bahçeşehir University's Center for Migration and Urban Studies, aims to enhance the capacity of policymakers, particularly those in municipalities involved in local governance. The program is also open to anyone interested in the subject, allowing a broader audience to benefit from the knowledge and skills provided.

The program focuses on identifying ecosystem changes and challenges related to migration, determining appropriate solutions, recognizing the need for updates in local policies, and creating roadmaps for sustainable cities.

The program, which has been organized for seven years, is one of Turkey's longest-running educational initiatives aimed at enhancing the awareness and knowledge of local policymakers regarding diverse views and perspectives on regional issues. It also seeks to bring together relevant groups working on these topics to foster capacity development.

6th BAU Local Advocacy School was designed this with the special theme of "Earthquake-Resilient Cities," aiming to address the increasing earthquake-related concerns following the February 6th earthquakes and contribute to collective empowerment. By the end of the two-day event, a highly impactful program was developed with the support of esteemed professors, significant NGOs, local government members and participants.

Bahçeşehir University's Center for Migration and Urban Studies (BAUMUS) conducted a session titled "Local Governments in Migration Governance in Cities." The session provided training on sustainability in the context of migration management, the requirements for managing migration at the local level, and the importance of migration terminology.

7th BAU Local Advocacy School was organized collaboration between Bahçeşehir University, the Marmara Municipalities Union and Local Monitoring, Research, and Implementation Association (YERELİZ)

As part of the training program, after introductory modules focusing on key topics such as understanding the municipal system, local actors, essential documents, and particularly the strategic plan and its functions, the emphasis shifted to urban needs and the role of local governments in developing social policies.

The process of preparing a strategic plan was then discussed in the context of participatory methods, sustainable development goals, and local advocacy.

The strategic plan writing workshop held at the end of the two-day training served as a guiding session for municipal teams aiming to prepare participatory and inclusive plans. It marked the first steps toward developing localized, sustainable plans aligned with global indicators.



BAU EARTHQUAKE DISASTER RISK REDUCTION WORKSHOP AND RESEARCH PROGRAM: Capacity Building for Local Governments In The Earthquake-Affected Region

The Earthquake Disaster Risk Reduction Workshop and Research Program, hosted by Bahçeşehir University, brought together participants, including local governments and municipal representatives on 18 April 2023. The purpose of this workshop was to support the capacity development of policymakers in light of international experience and knowledge accumulation.

The program welcomed a Japanese delegation composed of scientists and experts who experienced the Kobe earthquake, which resulted in significant losses in 1995 and became historically notable as the first instance of a skyscraper collapse due to an earthquake.

The delegation visited the earthquake-stricken areas in Kahramanmaraş and later participated in the Earthquake Disaster Risk Reduction Workshop and Research Program, where Bahçeşehir University Rector Prof. Dr. Şirin Karadeniz was also present.

The delegation, including Mr. Yukio Tanaka, Director of the Building Inspection and Zoning Department of Kobe Municipality, Mr. Masayoshi Nose, Director of the Kobe Municipal Crisis Management Center, and faculty members from Mukogawa Women's University, Prof. Tosu Shigeki, Prof. Yanagisawa Kazuhiko, Prof. Tagawa Hiroyuki, alongside BAU Faculty of Architecture Dean Prof. Dr. Murat Dündar, inspected heavily damaged buildings in cities such as Hatay, conducting technical assessments.

Prof. Dr. Murat Dündar emphasized the global resonance of the disaster Turkey faced, stating, "The scale of the disaster our country has experienced has attracted worldwide attention. In this context, Mukogawa University, with which our university has had a long-standing collaboration, and various public institutions in Japan immediately contacted us after the earthquake to discuss how we should proceed. At Bahçeşehir University, we consider it a social responsibility to raise awareness about disasters at all levels of society, and we have decided to establish a dedicated mechanism. We invited our partners and experts from Japan to accompany us in the establishment phase of the center, helping to investigate the causes that exacerbated the disaster and to provide consultancy."

Prof. Dündar further added, "Although it has been two months since the disaster, the situation remains dire. The significance of the visits to the region cannot be overstated, as they offer a glimmer of hope for the continuation of the recovery process. During our visits, we realized that the reconstruction of the region poses significant challenges. One of the main reasons we invited our colleagues from Japan is to collaborate in the region's rehabilitation. We need to create international public awareness and form partnerships with countries that have expertise, experience, and financial resources in this area to redesign the future of the earthquake-affected cities. Various projections regarding the financial needs of the region have been drawn, and it has been frequently mentioned that over \$100 billion in funding will be required for the region's redevelopment."

Prof. Yanagisawa Kazuhiko, speaking about his experience in the earthquake zone, stated, "In our research, we focused on the structural problems of buildings together with the academics from the university. I also had the opportunity to meet with the mayors of Çukurova and Kahramanmaraş. This allowed me to evaluate the situation from the perspective of local governance. As you know, Japan has also experienced major earthquakes, such as in Kobe and Eastern Japan. Here, I could feel the destructive power of nature up close. We cannot prevent earthquakes, but we must be prepared."

"URBANIZATION AND ISTANBUL" WORKSHOP in COLLABORATION WITH BAHÇEŞEHİR ÜNİVERSİTY AND THE ISTANBUL METROPOLITAN MUNICIPALITY'S ISTANBUL PLANNING AGENCY

Bahçeşehir University, in collaboration with the Istanbul Metropolitan Municipality's Istanbul Planning Agency (IPA), organized a workshop to evaluate how migration has transformed cities and the role of this process in urban planning.

As part of the activities organized by Bahçeşehir University's Center for Migration and Urban Studies (BAUMUS), the event titled "Urbanization and Istanbul" took place on December 22 at the Istanbul Planning Agency (IPA).

Moderated by BAUMUS founding director Prof. Dr. Ulaş Sunata, the event began with a presentation by Prof. Dr. Ahmet Özer titled "City and Urbanization." Prof. Dr. Özer provided an analytical explanation of urbanization, discussing developments in cities from 1923 to the present. He concluded his talk by giving examples of Turkish citizens' urbanization experiences.

Following this, Prof. Dr. Ulaş Sunata delivered a talk and highlighted how migration and the pandemic have transformed our lives in many ways. She emphasized the positive aspects of migration, noting that cities offer numerous opportunities and accessible public services. However, she also pointed out that, with the pandemic, not only our lives but also service delivery conditions have changed. Many services came into our homes, education continued remotely, and work patterns were updated. Additionally, the conditions of employment in the post-pandemic work environment also shifted.

Next, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Bülent Sezgin, in his talk "City and Art," discussed how culture forms the fundamental structure of a city. He emphasized that cities like Istanbul, with their multicultural societies, should reflect this cultural diversity in their art. Assoc. Prof. Sezgin also highlighted that the pandemic brought significant changes to the field of art and argued that both art and social solidarity became necessary during this time. He concluded by stressing the need for more accessible cultural and artistic opportunities for all.

The final speaker, IPA Secretary General Oktay Kargül, gave a talk titled "City and Planning," in which he discussed urban planning from 1900 to 2009. He explained how urban planning in the Istanbul Metropolitan Municipality (IMM) changed with Ekrem İmamoğlu's tenure as mayor, stating that these changes were based on thorough needs analyses conducted with all city stakeholders.
