BAU IN THE TIMES HIGHER EDUCATION

BAU participates in the Times Higher Education (THE) Impact Rankings since 2019. According to the current rankings, BAU belongs to the 801-1000 band in the World University Rankings, 59th in the Impact Rankings and the 173th in the Young University Rankings 2024. Also, BAU is ranked among the top 5 universities in Türkiye.

The university continuously increases its standing in categories related to the UN Sustainable Development Goals. As of 2025, BAU holds the following standings in the THE Impact Rankings;

Bahçeşehir University and SDG 4: Advancing Quality, Inclusive, and Lifelong Education

Bahçeşehir University (BAU) is deeply committed to advancing quality education for all, ensuring that learning serves as a transformative force not only for its students but also for the broader community.

Grounded in the principles of accessibility, inclusivity, and innovation, BAU's educational philosophy prioritizes academic excellence alongside social impact. The university integrates theory with practice, enabling students to develop the competencies, creativity, and ethical awareness required to thrive in a rapidly changing world.

Through interdisciplinary programs, experiential learning models, and global partnerships, BAU empowers individuals to become active contributors to sustainable development, aligning its efforts with the targets of Sustainable Development Goal 4 (Quality Education).

Extending beyond the boundaries of the university, BAU's educational mission reaches the wider society through community-oriented programs, public learning initiatives, and outreach training that promote lifelong learning and equitable access to knowledge.

By linking academic expertise with real-world challenges, the university fosters an ecosystem where education is both a personal right and a collective responsibility.

BAU CO-OP Education Model - Integrating Education and Employment

In line with Sustainable Development Goal 4 (Quality Education) and its target to ensure inclusive and equitable learning that prepares individuals for decent work and lifelong opportunities, Bahçeşehir University (BAU) established Türkiye's first CO-OP Education Model in 2008.

This pioneering initiative bridges the gap between academia and industry, ensuring that students acquire practical experience and professional competencies while completing their university education.

Through the CO-OP system, students undertake long-term internships ranging from three to nine months in BAU's partner companies, gaining hands-on experience in real business environments. These students, known as COOPERs, actively participate in projects, decision-making processes, and daily operations, integrating their academic knowledge with workplace practice.

The CO-OP model not only helps students identify their areas of interest and specialization but also provides a seamless transition to employment — many graduates receive job offers from the companies where they completed their internships.

Partner companies benefit equally, as they can identify and recruit skilled, industry-ready employees directly from among the COOPERs. collaboration framework.

By aligning higher education with workforce needs, the CO-OP Education Model contributes to sustained, inclusive, and productive employment, supporting both SDG 4 (Quality Education) and SDG 8 (Decent Work and Economic Growth) through its innovative university-industry collaboration framework.

BAU Joint Education Model

To further strengthen experiential learning and sectoral engagement, Bahçeşehir University's Faculty of Communication developed the Joint Education Model, a practice-oriented system that integrates academic learning with professional experience.

This model ensures that students in communication-related disciplines can apply theoretical knowledge in real industry settings, preparing them for successful careers upon graduation. Through partnerships with over 90 leading communication institutions across Türkiye, students participate in 14-week semester programs, working three days a week at professional organizations while continuing their coursework.

These experiences are fully recognized within the academic curriculum — students earn credit equivalent to two courses, graded jointly by the host institution and academic advisors based on their performance and learning outcomes.

The Joint Education Model allows students to gain experience in diverse fields such as advertising, design, gaming, digital media, corporate communications, and sound production, fostering early professional development and confidence.

Before each semester, students apply for available positions through an open and competitive recruitment process, ensuring equal access and authentic job interview experience.

By creating opportunities for applied learning, skill-building, and professional mentorship, BAU's Joint Education Model provides a transformative educational experience that links theory with practice.

It exemplifies the university's commitment to SDG 4 (Quality Education) by ensuring that students graduate not only with academic knowledge but also with the skills, experience, and confidence to thrive in their chosen professions.


Open Access Education for Lifelong Learning at BAU

Through these programs, Bahçeşehir University ensures that individuals of all ages and professional backgrounds can continuously enhance their knowledge and skills in an accessible and inclusive manner. The University's approach emphasizes open access to high-quality educational content, fostering intellectual growth, career advancement, and social development.

BAU Open Learning



Bahçeşehir University Open Learning Platform is a free and publicly accessible educational initiative established to promote open and inclusive learning opportunities for all. The platform offers a wide range of online course materials across diverse disciplines, meticulously prepared and curated by Bahçeşehir University's distinguished academic staff.

Designed to support both individual and professional development, the BAU Open Learning platform embodies the University's commitment to lifelong learning, digital education, and the democratization of knowledge. By providing high-quality educational content to learners worldwide, it enables participants to engage in self-paced learning and expand their intellectual horizons without financial or geographic barriers.

OpenBAU Platform Overview

Bahçeşehir University upholds equal opportunity in education as a core institutional value. In line with this principle, the OpenBAU platform has been developed to promote inclusivity and equal access to learning.

Accessibility and Design

OpenBAU is designed to reach a wide range of users, regardless of their device, software, or physical limitations. The platform is optimized for full accessibility, supporting screen readers and complete keyboard navigation. All features comply with international W3C Accessibility Standards. Its user-friendly interface minimizes the need for additional software and ensures all page content is accessible.

An accessibility menu, located at the bottom right corner of the homepage, allows users to customize their experience with tools such as color contrast options, text size adjustments, and alternative text descriptions, enhancing usability for visually impaired individuals.

Sign Language Education

To support the participation of hearing-impaired individuals, OpenBAU provides free sign language courses accessible to both students and the general public. This initiative encourages broader societal communication skills and inclusion.

Microsoft Teams Integration

Educational content on OpenBAU integrates with Microsoft Teams' Immersive Reader, allowing automatic text-to-speech playback for visually impaired users. Learners can also adjust line spacing, font size, and background colors for a more personalized and accessible learning experience.



FEJUST Guest Lectures and Open Access Materials (2023-2024)





As part of the Jean Monnet Chair on Feminist Epistemic Justice in the EU and Beyond (FEJUST), Bahçeşehir University offered a series of hybrid public lectures and online seminars under the title <u>Gendering EU Politics</u>. These sessions were open to both BAU students and the wider public, allowing participants outside the university to join via Zoom and YouTube Live. In addition, <u>lecture notes</u> prepared for the FEJUST undergraduate courses Gender Politics in the EU and Gender in International Development were published as open-access materials on the FEJUST website, providing free access to educational resources for external audiences.

BAU Software Talent Development Certificate Program



In cooperation with the Ministry of Industry and Technology of the Republic of Türkiye, Bahçeşehir University – Wissen Academy, and with the support of the Istanbul Development Agency (ISTKA), a comprehensive Software Talent Development Certificate Program was established under the Software Talent Training and Employment Center.

Launched in 2023, the program- fully free-of-charge- is scheduled to continue until the end of 2026, offering ongoing opportunities for young people to develop advanced software and digital skills, thereby contributing to sustainable employment and innovation in the technology sector.

The program is a 480-hour professional development initiative designed to train qualified young individuals for the software industry and meet the growing demand for skilled talent in this rapidly evolving sector. The program, implemented entirely free of charge within Bahçeşehir University, combines advanced technical training with career development components, ensuring that participants are well-prepared for the technology job market.

Following the completion of 480 hours of intensive instruction, participants are matched with employment opportunities in the software industry, facilitating a direct transition from training to professional practice.

The program welcomes candidates aged 18–35 who have been unemployed for at least one year or are recent graduates seeking to build careers in emerging technology fields. Over the course of four months, participants receive both technical and career-oriented education delivered by experienced instructors and industry professionals.

All participants who successfully complete the program are awarded a Professional Competency Certificate, validating their expertise and readiness to contribute to the software and technology ecosystem.

BAU Equal Opportunity in Technology Certification Program





Bahçeşehir University (BAU), in collaboration with CIFAL Istanbul, affiliated with the United Nations Institute for Training and Research (UNITAR), and in partnership with Yapı Kredi Bank, continues to advance its mission of promoting equality and innovation through the "Equal Opportunity in Technology Certification Program." This initiative is designed to increase women's participation in the fields of technology and innovation, contributing to the creation of a more inclusive and diverse digital future.

The certification program provides free, high-quality training delivered by Bahçeşehir University's distinguished academic staff. Participants engage in comprehensive learning modules covering Big Data, Artificial Intelligence, Cloud Technologies, Cybersecurity, the Internet of Things (IoT), and Industry 5.0. These training contents are developed with a focus on practical applicability and global standards, ensuring participants gain both theoretical knowledge and industry-relevant competencies.

In 2024, the program expanded its scope to reach a broader audience. It is now open to all women aged 15 and above, with no upper age limit, allowing greater inclusivity and ensuring that women of all ages can benefit from technological education and empowerment opportunities.

Participants who successfully complete the certification program and achieve a minimum score of 70 in the final evaluation will receive an E-Government Approved Certificate of Achievement, jointly accredited by UNITAR and Bahçeşehir University. Those who complete at least 75% of the coursework will be awarded a UNITAR-accredited Certificate of Participation.

The Equal Opportunity in Technology Certification Program is entirely free of charge and open to all women who wish to develop their skills and advance their careers in technology. Moreover, individuals of any gender residing in the "Hope Cities" established by Koç Holding after the Kahramanmaraş-centered earthquakes are also eligible to participate, reflecting Bahçeşehir University's unwavering commitment to social responsibility, inclusivity, and equal access to education.

Launched in 2023, the program has already achieved remarkable impact: by the end of 2024, a total of 22,450 women have successfully completed the training and received certificates. The certification program will continue until the end of 2026, aiming to reach and empower even more women across Türkiye and beyond through education, innovation, and equal opportunity. BAU Diplomat School













Bahçeşehir University's International Leadership Practice and Research Center (ULMER), operating under the Government Leadership School, continues to cultivate future leaders through the Diplomat School Program—a pioneering initiative in Türkiye distinguished by its unique name, format, and content. Over the years, the Diplomat School has hosted ministers, ambassadors, members of parliament, scholars, and thought leaders, providing participants with direct exposure to the mechanisms of diplomacy and international decision-making.

The Diplomat School offers a comprehensive educational experience open to anyone interested in diplomacy, international relations, and leadership development. The program is hosted at Bahçeşehir University's South Campus and serves as an accessible platform for individuals seeking to deepen their understanding of global affairs through academic and practical perspectives.

Participants who attend at least 75% of the sessions and successfully complete the final assessment receive a Certificate of Achievement, while those meeting only the attendance requirement are granted a Certificate of Participation.

Held for the 15th time in 2024, the program took place between September 23 and December 23, featuring a renewed curriculum and structure aligned with current global and diplomatic dynamics.

BAU Bridge Certificate Programs













The BAU Bridge Programs offer structured, practice-oriented, and certified learning opportunities designed to strengthen knowledge and skills across various disciplines. Established in 2021 under the Faculty of Economics, Administrative, and Social Sciences (FEAS), these programs have been continuously expanded and enriched through feedback from stakeholders and academic partners.

The BAU Bridge Certificate Programs are free of charge and open to all interested participants, reflecting Bahçeşehir University's commitment to inclusive education and its contribution to Sustainable Development Goal 4 (Quality Education) and Goal 10 (Reduced Inequalities).

By providing accessible, high-quality learning experiences, the programs support both students and external participants in developing essential competencies for academic, professional, and personal growth, while also promoting equal opportunities in education.

The 2024 term featured six distinct certificate programs, each designed and delivered in collaboration with BAU's departments, research centers, and partner institutions. These programs combine academic rigor with applied learning to equip participants with future-oriented competencies.

- 1. BAU-PUAM Neuropsychology Training (Level I:)Conducted by the BAU Psychology Application and Research Center (PUAM), this program offers foundational training in neuropsychology for psychology students and graduates. It includes both online theoretical modules and in-person practical sessions at the BAU Beşiktaş Campus, focusing on topics such as neuropsychological assessment, test applications, and cognitive evaluation methods.
- 2. Business Administration Certificate Program "Unlocking Opportunities: Al's Role in Business Success": Offered by the Department of Business Administration, this program explores the transformative potential of artificial intelligence in decision-making, innovation, and strategic business management. Participants engage with real-world case studies highlighting Al-driven growth and digital transformation.
- 3. International Finance Certificate Program "Sustainable Finance, Social Entrepreneurship, and Innovation Perspectives for a Green Future": Led by the Department of International Finance, this program examines the intersection of sustainability, innovation, and social entrepreneurship. Participants gain insights into sustainable finance practices and inclusive growth strategies with contributions from both academia and the finance sector.
- 4. Political Science and International Relations Certificate Program "Diplomacy in a Changing World Order": This program addresses the evolution of global diplomacy, international governance, and geopolitical transformations, offering participants the analytical tools to understand and interpret contemporary international relations.
- 5. Economics Certificate Program "Global Economic Challenges and Digital Transformation": Organized by the Department of Economics, this course focuses on macroeconomic change, digital economies, and innovation policies, equipping participants with analytical perspectives on global and national economic trends.
- 6. Sociology Certificate Program "Gender, Society, and Social Responsibility": Offered by the Department of Sociology, this program emphasizes social inclusion, gender equality, and civic engagement, encouraging participants to analyze societal transformations through a multidisciplinary lens.

Each program provides a certificate upon successful completion and serves as a platform for both students and external participants to develop skills relevant to today's rapidly changing social and economic landscape.

By bridging academia, industry, and society, the BAU Bridge Certificate Programs reflect Bahçeşehir University's commitment to lifelong learning, innovation, and equal opportunity in education.

BAU Software Talent Development Certificate Program





On 13 December, the Bahçeşehir University's CIFAL Istanbul, UNITAR team organized a meaningful educational event in Battalgazi, Malatya titled "Heroes of Nature: Raising Awareness on Sustainability,", offering support and inspiration to children and their parents affected by the February 6 earthquakes.

During the seminar, CIFAL Istanbul personnel introduced participants to the mission and values of the United Nations, explaining how individuals can actively contribute to achieving the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The speakers addressed key topics such as clean water conservation, renewable energy, sustainable cities, climate action, and the protection of natural ecosystems. Presentations focused particularly on waste reduction and the long-term benefits of adopting eco-friendly lifestyles within families and communities. At the conclusion of the event, the CIFAL Istanbul team presented books to the participating children and joined them in a tote bag painting workshop, reinforcing messages of creativity, sustainability, and collective responsibility for the environment. The initiative reflected Bahçeşehir University's dedication to providing quality education beyond its own campus, extending academic expertise to external learning environments.

The following day, on 15 December, the BAU CIFAL Istanbul team, held a series of official meetings with local authorities in Malatya, one of the provinces most affected by the earthquakes of February 6. The delegation first met with the Head of the Strategy Development Department at the Malatya Metropolitan Municipality, where discussions focused on possible improvements in the region, including the sustainable reconstruction of schools, educational initiatives, and potential collaborations to enhance the quality of learning in the area. Later, the team visited the Deputy Mayor of Battalgazi Municipality to exchange views on the city's recovery efforts, social service delivery, and evolving community needs. Both meetings aimed to identify areas for cooperation that align with the principles of Sustainable Development Goal 16: Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions, emphasizing transparent governance, institutional resilience, and inclusive local partnerships.

By engaging directly with local administrations and delivering educational activities on-site, Bahçeşehir University and CIFAL Istanbul continues to expand the social impact of higher education — supporting sustainable recovery and promoting quality learning opportunities in regions most in need.

These sessions enabled students to strengthen essential competencies such as critical thinking, problem-solving, communication, and leadership.

Reflecting Bahçeşehir University's mission to make quality education accessible to all, the MOVE UP Programme remains free of charge and open to high school students throughout Türkiye, ensuring equal access to transformative educational experiences. By fostering youth capacity development and awareness in key 21st-century skill areas, Bahçeşehir University continues to extend its educational impact beyond the university campus—contributing to the formation of an informed, capable, and socially responsible generation ready to shape a sustainable future.

BAU Conservatory Open Classes



As part of its mission to make arts and culture accessible to the wider community, Bahçeşehir University Conservatory (BAU Conservatory) continued to organize its Open Classes in 2024, inviting high school students to experience professional performing arts education firsthand. In 2024, the number and scope of open classes were further expanded to include a broader range of disciplines within the Department of Performing Arts.

- Shakespeare Theatre led by Assoc. Prof. Dr. Elif Baş, and
- Musical Theatre led by Lecturer Adnan Ata Yiğit.

These classes, held on May 25, 2024, provided an immersive experience in stage performance, acting techniques, and musical expression. The program allowed young participants to interact directly with BAU's academic staff and gain a deeper understanding of performing arts education.

Through such initiatives, BAU Conservatory continues to strengthen its role as a cultural and educational hub, contributing to public education and fostering appreciation for the arts in society.

Open Lecture: "What Is Social Benefit? (24.12.2024)

By combining theory, practice, and sustainability, the workshop fostered learning, skill development, and environmental responsibility among participants. It also highlighted how technological innovation can serve as a catalyst for sustainable development and the future workforce.

BAU Radio Fest: Open Seminar on Animal Welfare in the Context of Sustainable Development Goals (14.10.2024)



During the 2024 BAU Radio Fest, Bahçeşehir University, in collaboration with CIFAL Istanbul, UNITAR and HAÇİKO – Association for the Protection of Animals from Desperation and Indifference, a prominent non-governmental organization dedicated to animal welfare, hosted an open and free-to-attend session titled "Animal Welfare in the Context of the SDGs." The event was designed to engage both BAU students and the wider public, reflecting the University's ongoing commitment to sustainability, ethics, and community engagement.

The session focused on the relationship between animal welfare and sustainable development, highlighting how compassion, ethical awareness, and collective social responsibility contribute to healthier and more livable urban environments. Discussions addressed the protection of stray animals' rights, the promotion of sustainable urban practices, and the role of public awareness and civic participation in advancing the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals, particularly SDG 11 (Sustainable Cities and Communities) and SDG 15 (Life on Land.

Social Sciences in the Age of Artificial Intelligence Open Lecture: New Career Opportunities and Research Methods (25.07.2024)



This open lecture explored the impact of artificial intelligence on the social sciences. Participants gained insights into Al's influence on research methods, emerging career opportunities, and practical applications such as data analysis, modeling human behavior, and understanding societal dynamics. The event aimed to raise awareness among social scientists on effectively leveraging Al, supporting inclusive and quality education, fostering innovative skills for the workforce, and promoting technological advancement.

Social Sciences in the Age of Artificial Intelligence Open Lecture: New Career Opportunities and Research Methods (25.07.2024)

By facilitating an open forum for constructive discussion, the event contributed to SDG 16 (Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions), supporting efforts to build a more peaceful and inclusive international order.

Global Affairs Seminar Series: Public Session on Beyond the Headlines, A Discussion on Foreign Policy Analysis (13.05.2024)



The Global Affairs Seminar Series offers a comprehensive and in-depth examination of current international developments, providing a public academic platform that brings together scholars, practitioners, policy makers, political actors, students, and members of the public interested in global issues.

In this session, distinguished speakers went beyond traditional foreign policy analysis to explore contemporary challenges through the lens of strategic thinking in international relations. Participants gained meaningful insights into national security strategies, crisis management, and global diplomacy, examining how these elements interact in today's complex geopolitical environment.

The seminar also served as a free and open forum where speakers and participants representing diverse political perspectives could engage in respectful and intellectually safe discussions. This inclusive approach encouraged the free exchange of ideas and critical dialogue on key global topics, reflecting Bahçeşehir University's strong commitment to academic freedom, pluralism, and constructive debate.

Featuring presentations by expert authors and academics, the event offered innovative perspectives that inspired deeper reflection and collaboration. BAU INNOVATION FOCUS OPEN TRAINING PROGRAM





The 7th edition of the BAU Innovation Focus Program, organized by the BAU Hub Incubation Center in collaboration with the BAU Technology Transfer Office (TTO) was held during the 2024 Fall Semester.

This free and open-access educational program aimed to raise awareness and share knowledge on entrepreneurship, innovation, project development, patent application processes, incentives, and available supports. Through informative presentations and experience-sharing sessions, participants gained valuable insights into the entrepreneurial ecosystem and innovation landscape.

The program took place between November 12 and 19, 2024, and was conducted across two interactive sessions designed to inspire participants to take their first steps into the world of projects, startups, and innovation.

In addition to these thematic sessions, the program also featured entrepreneurship training modules focusing on:

- How to find and validate innovative ideas
- How to design and write effective project proposals
- Fundamentals of entrepreneurship and business modeling
- Accessing funding, incentives, and patent registration processes
- Case studies and experience sharing from successful BAU entrepreneurs and alumni

The BAU Innovation Focus Program provided an inclusive learning environment for students, young professionals, and aspiring entrepreneurs, helping them to develop their entrepreneurial mindset and creative problem-solving skills.

Netflix x BAU: Collaborative Pathways for Innovation in Communication and Media (16.10.2024)

Sustainable Logistics and Supply Chain Open Panel (24.10.2024)

Zero Tolerance for Violences Seminar Series (30.10.2024/25.11.2024)





The project "Zero Tolerance to Violence on My Campus", hosted by Bahçeşehir University (BAU) in collaboration with CIFAL Istanbul and UNITAR, and supported by the Yanındayız Association and the Consulate General of the Federal Republic of Germany in Istanbul, aimed to raise awareness about dating violence and to promote gender-sensitive approaches within higher education environments.

Held at Bahçeşehir University, the initiative consisted of three interactive sessions, including trainings, workshops, and a public panel open to all university students. These sessions created a participatory platform for developing concrete solutions, encouraging gender equality, reducing inequalities, and fostering cooperation across institutions and communities.





Politics and Society Seminar Series: Bridging Justice and Gender, Analyzing Organizational Dynamics In Istanbul's Local Governance Through Studying Up and Scorecard Analysis (15.11.2024)



Organized by Bahçeşehir University (BAU), this open seminar focused on gender justice and the organizational dynamics within local governments, providing a learning platform for local government representatives and policy makers.

With BAU alumna Melis Arıksoy as guest speaker, the session explored the relationship between fairness in governance structures, gender equality, and the creation of inclusive decision-making environments. Invisible Chains: Multidimensional Strategies To End Modern Slavery (02.12.2024)

The event addressed human trafficking and modern slavery from a multidimensional and policy-oriented perspective, bringing together students, academics, and policy makers for an open and educational discussion.

Speakers explored the global and local dimensions of these critical issues, emphasizing the importance of reducing inequalities, promoting peace and justice, and strengthening institutional frameworks to combat exploitation. The panel also provided participants with valuable educational insights into the social, economic, and legal aspects of modern slavery, fostering awareness and collaboration across sectors in the fight for human dignity and equality.

Womens' Human Rights and Participatory Democracy (05.12.2024)



As part of Women's Rights Day, Bahçeşehir University (BAU), CIFAL Istanbul, UNITAR, the Gender Equality Monitoring Association (FEJUST), and BAU's Political Science and International Relations Club jointly organized the webinar "Women's Rights and Participatory Democracy."

The event explored the interconnections between women's rights and inclusive democratic participation, highlighting the importance of empowering women in civic and political life. Through engaging discussions and expert contributions, the webinar encouraged strategies to reduce inequalities, promote active citizenship, and strengthen democratic inclusion.

FEASS Research Seminars: Supervising In The Age Of AI, Navigating Student Use Of ChatGPT In Graduate and Undergraduate Work (24.12.2024)



Newton and the Global Legacy of Newtonianism



Bahçeşehir University hosted the international workshop "Newton and the Global Legacy of Newtonianism" between 11–15 November 2024 at its Beşiktaş South Campus, Faculty of Law Building.

The event brought together approximately 15 international scholars from diverse disciplines to critically examine Eurocentric approaches to Newtonian studies and to explore global methodological perspectives emerging in the field.

Through presentations and discussions, participants reflected on the cultural, philosophical, and scientific dimensions of Newtonianism, highlighting its enduring influence across different world regions. The workshop demonstrated Bahçeşehir University's commitment to fostering international academic dialogue and advancing inclusive, cross-cultural perspectives in the history of science.

TechCamp 2024: Digital Innovation for Disaster Preparedness



Bahçeşehir University hosted TechCamp 2024, a three-day educational hackathon designed to raise awareness about earthquakes and promote disaster preparedness through digital games and interactive storytelling.

The event brought together university students, educators, and professionals from the technology and creative industries to co-develop innovative tools that enhance public understanding of disaster resilience. Participants took part in mentorship sessions and hands-on training led by experts in digital media, technology, and disaster management, enabling them to design socially impactful game prototypes that communicate messages of safety, resilience, and solidarity during natural disasters.

Organized in collaboration with the U.S. Embassy and various local partners, TechCamp 2024 combined education, technology, and civic engagement within the framework of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

The program provided free, inclusive workshops on earthquake preparedness, digital storytelling, and game design for social good, empowering young innovators to use technology as a force for community awareness and collective resilience.

Creative Drama Workshop in Education



Bahçeşehir University's Children's Club organized the "Creative Drama Workshop in Education" on 23 October 2024 at the Beşiktaş South Campus.

The session, led by Utku Haser, focused on the use of creative drama as an innovative pedagogical method to enhance learning experiences and student engagement.

The workshop provided participants with practical tools to integrate drama techniques into educational contexts, fostering creativity, communication, and emotional expression in teaching.

Bahçeşehir University and Zorlu PSM Launch the "PSM Academy Stage Technician Program"



Bahçeşehir University and Zorlu Performing Arts Center (PSM) have launched a new educational partnership to train stage technicians, the behind-the-scenes professionals who make theater, ballet, opera, dance, and music performances possible.

The "PSM Academy Stage Technician Program", which began on 4 May 2024, is a 51-hour certificate training designed to equip participants with fundamental knowledge and practical skills in stage technologies, including sound, lighting, and video systems. Participants also receive instruction in occupational safety, basic electronics, and stage automation.

Led by a team of Bahçeşehir University faculty members and industry experts, the program combines theoretical training and hands-on workshops held at Zorlu PSM. Upon successful completion of the program and evaluation process, participants receive certification qualifying them to work as Entry-Level Stage Technicians in live performance settings.

By fostering collaboration between academia and the performing arts industry, the program strengthens vocational training, creative industry development, and employment opportunities, supporting Sustainable Development Goal 4 (Quality Education) and SDG 8 (Decent Work and Economic Growth) through inclusive and skill-oriented education.

Bahçeşehir University and Partners Host the 5th Independent Businessmen Meeting in Baku





The 5th Independent Businessmen Meeting was held in Baku at the JW Marriott Absheron Hotel on 29 April 2024, organized by the MÜSİAD Azerbaijan Production and Trade Commission in collaboration with Bahçeşehir University (BAU) and the Azerbaijan Food and Beverage Industry Association (AQISA).

The event brought together more than 220 entrepreneurs and business leaders, along with members of MÜSİAD Azerbaijan, to strengthen commercial relations, foster new partnerships, and exchange insights on both the national and global economy.

Bahçeşehir University and TÜBİTAK Host the ICAAM 2024 International Conference on Analysis and Applied Mathematics in Antalya



The 7th International Conference on Analysis and Applied Mathematics (ICAAM 2024) was successfully held in Antalya, organized with the support of Bahçeşehir University (BAU) and the Scientific and Technological Research Council of Türkiye (TÜBİTAK). The conference brought together 214 participants from 21 countries, fostering international collaboration and knowledge exchange in the fields of analysis, modeling, and applied mathematics.

The event opened with a welcoming address by Prof. Dr. Arif Engin, Dean of the BAU Faculty of Engineering and Natural Sciences. Supported by the strong academic foundation built through BAU's weekly "Analysis and Applied Mathematics" seminars, ICAAM 2024 once again demonstrated Bahçeşehir University's leadership in fostering international scientific dialogue, promoting research excellence, and contributing to the advancement of mathematical sciences.

Bahçeşehir University and Oyak Renault Launch the Student Academy Certificate Program



Bahçeşehir University (BAU), in collaboration with Oyak Renault, has launched the Student Academy Certificate Program, an inclusive educational initiative open to engineering students from all universities across Türkiye.

The program offers young engineers the opportunity to gain hands-on experience in real industrial environments, combining academic knowledge with practical application in the automotive and manufacturing sectors. Designed to develop future skills and promote innovation, the program includes project-based learning, mentorship from industry professionals, and training sessions on both technical and personal development, with several modules delivered by Bahçeşehir University faculty members.

Participants work in interdisciplinary teams, developing competencies in digital transformation, problem-solving, leadership, and collaboration. The program concludes with a Factory Day, where students visit the Oyak Renault facility and present their final projects to industry experts.

Upon successful completion, participants receive a joint certificate issued by Bahçeşehir University and Oyak Renault, recognizing their achievement and professional growth.

Conference on Sustainability Awareness for High School Students by BAU (26.11.2024)



Additionally, lecture notes from the FEJUST undergraduate courses Gender Politics in the EU and Gender in International Development were made publicly available as open-access materials on the FEJUST website. This approach democratized education and empowered individuals outside academia to engage with feminist and equality-focused perspectives in international relations.

This initiative directly contributes to SDG 5: Gender Equality by fostering feminist scholarship and ensuring women's and gender perspectives are integrated into academic and policy discourse. FEJUST Training Programme on Gender, Justice and Policy (2023)

Within the framework of the Jean Monnet Chair on Feminist Epistemic Justice in the EU and Beyond (FEJUST), Bahçeşehir University launched the FEJUST Training Programme on Gender, Justice and Policy in 2023. The programme included certificate courses such as Gender in International Development, Gender in EU Politics (undergraduate level), Gender and Development, and Gender Politics in the EU Politics (postgraduate level), conducted between October 2022 and July 2025. These free and accessible courses were open to both university students and external participants, providing certificates co-funded by the European Union.

Through this initiative, Bahçeşehir University has strengthened its dedication to SDG 5 by advancing gender equality in education, promoting feminist perspectives in policymaking, and supporting women's participation in academic and policy-oriented fields. The training programme encouraged students to critically analyze gender dynamics within international and European political systems, fostering awareness of social justice and inclusive governance.

FEJUST Training Programme on Gender, Justice and Policy (2023)







FEJUST Mentorship and Research Support for Emerging Scholars (2023–2024)



Within the framework of the Jean Monnet Chair on Feminist Epistemic Justice in the EU and Beyond (FEJUST), Dr. Rahime Süleymanoğlu-Kürüm established mentoring and research-support mechanisms to enhance women's participation in academic publishing and EU studies. Undergraduate students Ceren Çolakoğlu and İbrahim Ekrem Sarı received close guidance in drafting policy papers, one later published in Academicus and another in Panorama Global Academy. This mentoring process enabled students to gain authorship experience and visibility in debates on gender and EU policy.

Female students were further encouraged to pursue master's theses on gender equality and civil-society engagement—such as Ala Khaled's research on EU support for women's NGOs and Sura Salmanlı's study on women's rights in Azerbaijan. Dr. Süleymanoğlu-Kürüm also led trainings within the SDG 5 Türkiye Network, where students collaborated with professionals, strengthening women's access to research, publication, and policymaking arenas.

Through the Feminist Eleştiri Journal special issue, undergraduate contributors—including İbrahim Ekrem Sarı, Ceren Orhan, and Ceren Çolakoğlu—were mentored throughout the writing and review process, marking their first academic publication experience. Collectively, these efforts reflect Bahçeşehir University's sustained commitment to fostering gender-responsive research culture and supporting young scholars in their professional growth.

This initiative directly contributes to SDG 5: Gender Equality by advancing women's participation and leadership in academic research, and it also aligns with SDG 4: Quality Education and SDG 10: Reduced Inequalities through its inclusive approach to mentorship and scholarly collaboration.





FEJUST Early Career Researcher Workshops and Dialogues (2023–2025)






Under the Jean Monnet Chair on Feminist Epistemic Justice in the EU and Beyond (FEJUST), Bahçeşehir University launched a series of Early Career Researcher Workshops (ECRWs) and FEJUST Dialogues to strengthen gender equality and epistemic justice within EU studies. Organized in collaboration with the University of Liverpool's Europe and the World Centre, the ECRW series brought together emerging scholars from Turkey, the UK, and across Europe for mentoring, paper presentations, and structured academic feedback.


Each workshop served as an international capacity-building forum, where participants—many of them early-career women—received detailed guidance on research design, writing, and presentation. The FEJUST Dialogues extended this engagement to civil society through partnerships with organizations such as the Gender Equality Monitoring Association (CEİD), featuring events that marked Women's Rights Day and Europe Day.

Through these collaborative activities, Bahçeşehir University promoted inclusive knowledge production and cross-sectoral dialogue, helping embed feminist and participatory perspectives in both academic and policy contexts.

This initiative directly contributes to SDG 5: Gender Equality by empowering early-career women researchers and promoting inclusive research ecosystems. Embedding Equality through Participatory Research and FEJUST Policy Work (2023–2024)







Under the Jean Monnet Chair on Feminist Epistemic Justice in the EU and Beyond (FEJUST), Bahçeşehir University integrated the principles of equality and anti-discrimination into both research design and publication processes. Students were trained in Participatory Action Research (PAR) methodologies—such as photovoice and video documentation—to capture lived experiences of gender, inclusion, and social justice.

The PAR Synthesis Reports (2023–2024), co-authored by Dr. Rahime Süleymanoğlu-Kürüm and her students, exemplify inclusive and non-hierarchical authorship by representing youth and women's perspectives equitably. Together with the FEJUST Policy Briefs on diversity and epistemic justice, these works demonstrate how Bahçeşehir University transforms equality principles into practice by giving visibility to marginalized voices within academic research and policy dialogue.

This initiative directly contributes to SDG 5: Gender Equality through participatory and inclusive research practices, and it also aligns with SDG 4: Quality Education, SDG 10: Reduced Inequalities, and SDG 16: Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions by fostering equity, representation, and democratic knowledge production.

Mentoring Through FEJUST Teaching and Integrating Undergraduate and Postgraduate Students into Early Career Researcher Workshops (2023–2025)







Within the framework of the Jean Monnet Chair on Feminist Epistemic Justice in the EU and Beyond (FEJUST), Bahçeşehir University embedded mentoring into both teaching and research-development activities. In the undergraduate and postgraduate course Gender Politics in the EU, students followed a structured research and writing process resembling professional academic supervision. They developed individualized reading lists and two sequential term papers, receiving detailed feedback at each stage—from reading selection to final submission.

Students also presented their preliminary findings during the Early Career Researcher Workshop series, where they benefited from peer and expert commentary. This mentoring process enhanced research design, critical thinking, and academic writing competencies, while particularly supporting women students in pursuing independent research and postgraduate studies. Several mentees later published or presented their work in academic venues such as Academicus, Panorama Global Academy, and Feminist Eleştiri, illustrating the tangible outcomes of this mentoring model.

This initiative directly contributes to SDG 5: Gender Equality by strengthening women's participation and leadership in academic research, and it also aligns with SDG 4: Quality Education and SDG 10: Reduced Inequalities through its inclusive and supportive approach to higher education mentorship.

Fostering Safe Spaces and Voice through FEJUST (2023-2024)



Within the framework of the Jean Monnet Chair on Feminist Epistemic Justice in the EU and Beyond (FEJUST), Bahçeşehir University has adopted an approach to teaching and public engagement grounded in feminist principles of safety, respect, and voice. Although FEJUST does not operate under a formal code of conduct, its practices ensure that all participants can express their perspectives freely and without fear of discrimination or retaliation.

The first FEJUST Policy Brief, "When Youth Refuse Silence: Safe Spaces and the Politics of Voice," examined how to create inclusive environments where marginalized experiences are acknowledged and valued. This principle is consistently reflected in FEJUST classrooms and workshops, which open with affirmations of mutual respect and equal participation, and where participants may confidentially raise concerns with the Chair coordinator. By embedding these principles into both academic and participatory settings, Bahçeşehir University demonstrates a proactive model of inclusivity and care in higher education.

This initiative directly contributes to SDG 5: Gender Equality by promoting safety, empowerment, and equal participation, and it also aligns with SDG 4: Quality Education and SDG 16: Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions through its emphasis on respect, inclusion, and accountability in academic environments.

BAUGO: "Women and Technology: Discover Your Role and Enhance Your Potential"



Conducted by Prof. Dr. Ebru Canan-Sokullu, this training focused on exploring women's role in the technology field and strengthening their participation in an increasingly digital world. It emphasized that while women today are shaping technology as innovators, leaders, and creators, gender inequality and stereotypes continue to limit equal access and representation.

Based on modules such as historical perspectives on equality in technology, gender and equal opportunity, international approaches, statistical insights, and women's contribution to science and technology in Türkiye, the training encouraged participants to reflect on challenges and strategies for achieving equality in tech. By promoting awareness and empowering women to take active roles in technological innovation, Bahçeşehir University highlighted its commitment to inclusive and equitable progress in this field.

Through a gender-focused synthesis and citation analysis, participants explored the visibility of women scholars and feminist approaches in the field, gaining insights into inclusive methodologies and representation in international studies.

By encouraging critical reflection on gender biases in academia and fostering cross-disciplinary dialogue, Bahçeşehir University contributed to advancing inclusive education, equality, and cooperation among researchers and policymakers.

Delivered by Bahçeşehir University alumna Melis Arıksoy, this seminar examined the intersection of gender justice and organizational structures in local governance. Drawing from practical insights, the discussion highlighted how data-driven approaches such as scorecard analysis can evaluate institutional performance and promote fairness, accountability, and inclusivity in municipal contexts.

By linking gender equality with transparent and participatory governance, Bahçeşehir University underscored the importance of education, dialogue, and research in strengthening institutions and fostering a culture of equality and justice.

The event examined the relationship between women's rights and democratic participation, emphasizing the importance of inclusion, representation, and civic engagement in advancing social justice.

Through expert discussions and participant interaction, the webinar fostered awareness of how strengthening women's voices in governance contributes to more equitable, participatory, and transparent decision-making processes.

It also introduces a Continuing Professional Development (CPD) Programme designed to equip career counselors with new methods and tools to guide women toward opportunities in the digital economy. Furthermore, the Learning Laboratory and Online Forum foster the exchange of good practices, interactive learning, and collaboration among students, educators, and professionals through multilingual open-access resources.

By combining innovation, inclusion, and education, the Future Women Project bridges the gap between academic goals, labor market needs, and individual aspirations—empowering women to thrive in the evolving digital landscape. EarlySTEM Workshop for Preschool Teachers - 1st Term (26.08.2024)



"Let's Extract the DNA of a Strawberry" Workshop within the Science Will Win with Youth Project (13.06.2024)



The workshop focused on sharing upcoming STEM activities for the second semester of the 2023–2024 academic year and on strengthening teachers' capacity for effective classroom integration. Through this collaboration, Bahçeşehir University has once again emphasized its commitment to advancing inclusive, high-quality STEM education and nurturing 21st-century skills among educators and students alike.

The program began with opening remarks by Dr. Defne Yabaş, Director of the BAUSTEM Center at Bahçeşehir University, and Gözde Yılmaz, Head of the EarlySTEM & STEM Department at Uğur Schools.
