- Manage common diseases at the primary-care level
- Distinguish emergent situations and perform the first interventions
- Refer to a specialist when needed
- Know and apply preventive health services in the related clerkships

Clinical Practice — What You Will Do

- Take patient histories and perform complete physical examinations on patients at the bedside
- Perform your block's basic medical practices — from vital signs and asepsis to suturing, abdominal and breast examination
- Attend the settings each block includes: ward rounds, operating room, delivery room, emergency service, biochemistry laboratory
- Present cases, give student presentations, and prepare epicrisis (discharge summary) reports
- Homeworks: prescriptions, family trees, consent forms, emergency-case preparation

- is an interdisciplinary medical humanities series designed to enrich the scientific, intellectual and personal development of students and faculty through shared learning and reflection.

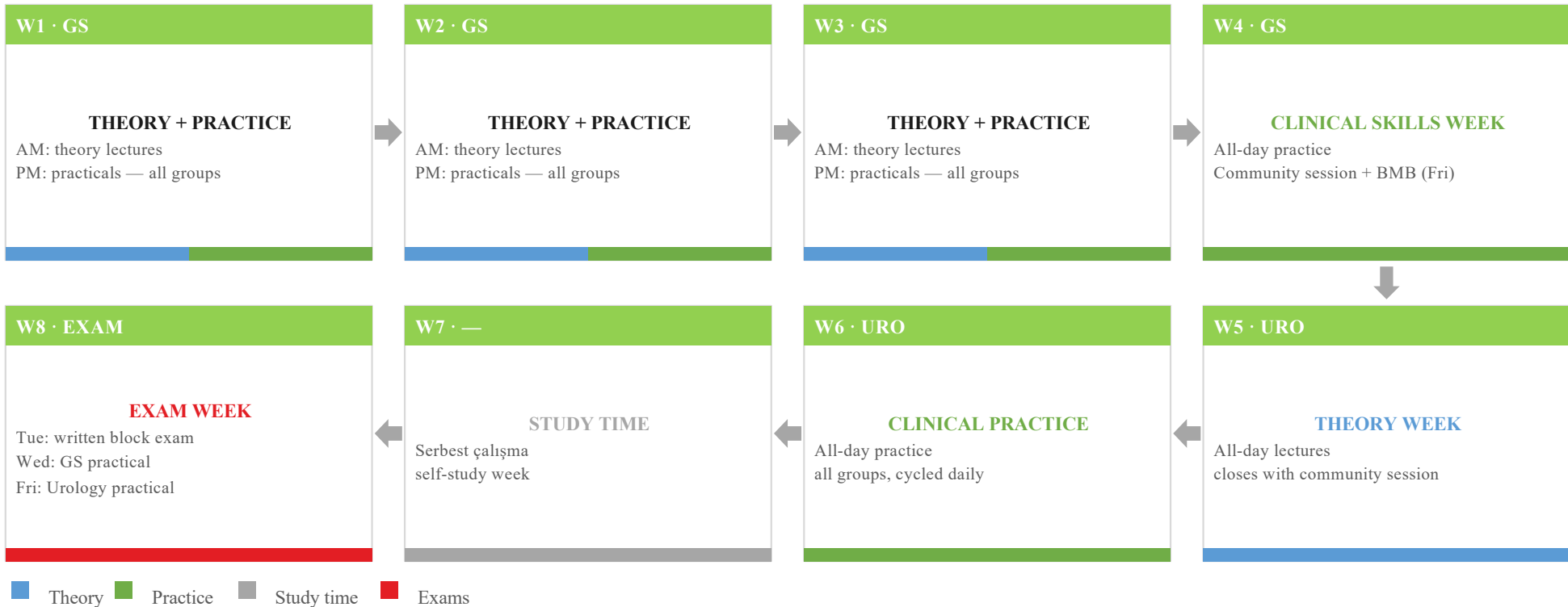

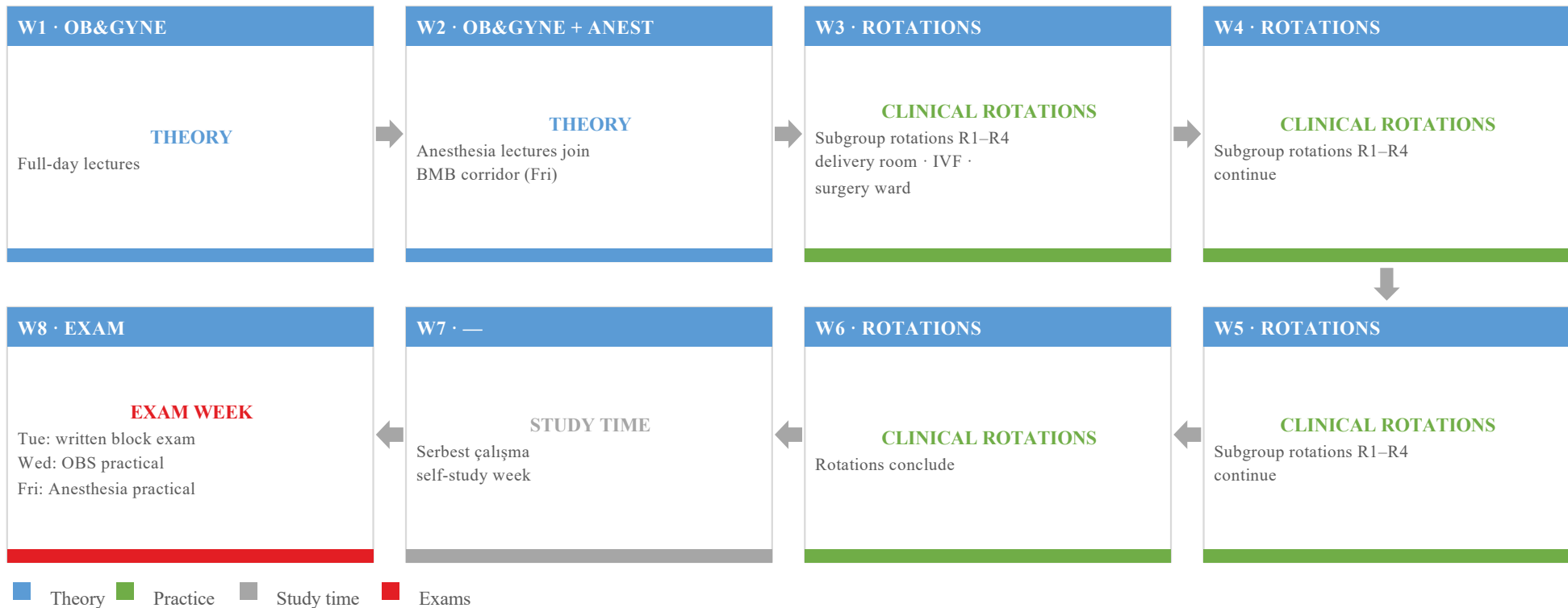

Grading — What Changed

LAST YEAR

- Each clerkship had its own mix
- Midterm 5–10 % + performance 10–15 % + oral 40 % + written 40 %
- Separate logbook / seminar / case presentation percentages in some clerkships
- Hard to compare across clerkships

THIS YEAR

• ONE uniform scheme for every block:

- Student participation 20 %
- Oral exam 40 %
- Written exam 40 %

Grading — What Changed

- Student Participation 20%:
- Specific criteria and their weighting are determined at the discretion of the relevant departments.
 - Active participation and contribution
 - Clerkship logbook performance
 - Bedside assessments
 - Case-based activities

The 75 / 25 Rule

- Each block gives ONE integrated grade for its two clerkships
- Main clerkship of the block: 75 % of the grade
- Second clerkship of the block: 25 % of the grade
- You have to get minimum 60/100 points from each clerkship.
- **You pass or fail the BLOCK as a whole — 70/100 to pass**

Worked example

General Surgery 74 · Urology 82 → block grade = $74 \times 0.75 + 82 \times 0.25 = 76$ → PASS (≥ 70)

The two clerkship grades blend into ONE block grade — you pass or fail the block as a whole, never clerkship by clerkship.

Worked example

General Surgery 76 · Urology 59 → block grade = $76 \times 0.75 + 59 \times 0.25 = 72$ → FAIL

Although the weighted block grade is ≥ 70 , each clerkship grade must also be at least 60.

The Logbook System

- Each block has its own logbook
- Lists the skills and procedures you must complete during the block
- Each item has a target learning level (1–4) and a signature column
- Performance items are graded by the supervising physician
- **The logbook is a critical part of your assessment — it feeds the participation grade**

Logbook Rules

- Collect your logbook from the Student Affairs Office WITH signature, before the internship starts
- Collect signatures DURING the clerkship, not in exam week
- **Do NOT make copies — every logbook carries original signatures**
- If you lose it: petition the DEAN'S OFFICE (not the coordinator!)
- Signatures come from the physician who directly supervised the activity

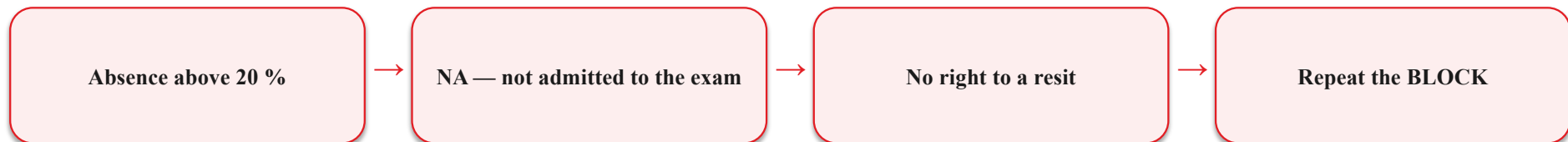
Bring your logbook to the oral exam!

- No logbook → the oral exam cannot be assessed properly

Attendance — 80 % Compulsory

- 80 % attendance is compulsory in every clerkship (Regulation, Part 4, Item 16, 5)
- **No excuses are accepted — even a medical report does not restore attendance**
- All absences, excused or not, are deducted from your attendance period
- Exceeding the 20 % limit → you cannot take the exam (NA)
- **NA students cannot enter make-up exams and must REPEAT the BLOCK**
